- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 12.0% since 2017, growing by 10,996. Population is expected to increase by 11.7% between 2022 and 2027, adding 11,946.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 10.3% in Walton County, GA from 26,797 to 29,559. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.3% to 60.4% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.9% of Walton County, GA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.9% below the national average), and **8.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends










Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Growing Occupations



Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Earnings




